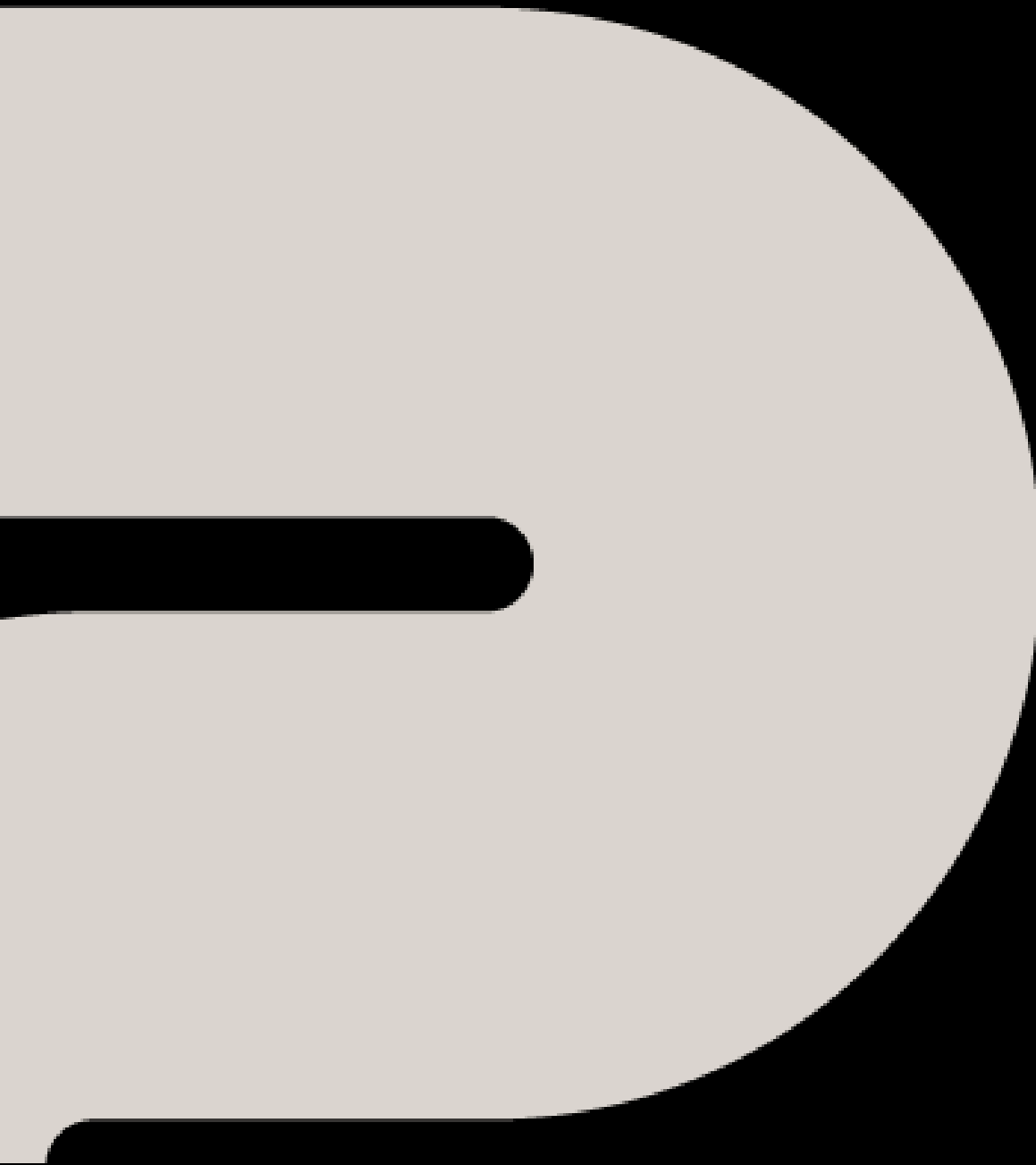

Clothing & Numbers (Art. 21)

Shirt number – front left side (10 cm)

Shirt number - back center (between 12 and 20 cm)

Hand protection (Art 22.)

Uniform Colours (2 contrasting colours)

Competition Regulations – WWR Interim Uniform Policy (see below)

Uniform sponsorship logos must be grouped in the centre of the shirt (front & back – back includes sleeve space) each grouping must not exceed 160 cm² (including sleeves). In addition to the manufacturer's logo Uniform manufacturer logo max 30 cm².

No sponsor marks are permitted on gloves, shoes, sleeves or headgear. Manufacturing mark on padded head gear 10cm²

No sponsor marks are permitted on the back of the chair or on the frame, other than the manufacturers logo as commercially available (The WWR or LOC reserves the right to use this space)

Competition spoke guards may have a sponsor logo space of 160 cm². Sponsor logos on all competition wheels must look the same (including wheels on the bench)
